This implementation guide is for the [IT administrator / network manager](#) in the school.

Behaviour Online is simple & easy to use. As with many initial websites accessed via a secure school system there are the usual requirements for IT administrators/Network Managers to implement. Once this has been undertaken Behaviour support & teaching staff will be able to access & use content easily.

### Staff Access:

In order to access the subscription only material, you will need to log on using your Account name and Access Code found at the top right of webpage.



These access details are for any and all staff at your school only to share. Please do pass your Access code on to your colleagues within your school so that they too can benefit from BehaviourOnline.

### Using the website:

For those familiar with the internet, use of the site will be largely self explanatory, but if you need it, then the 'How to use this site' link at the top of the page should provide all the help you require.

We suggest that you search around the website freely and familiarise yourself fully with it in order to gain maximum benefit from it.

### Licence restrictions:

- Please do not share your Access details with anyone who does not work for your school.
- Your access account allows use only in the school or unit, not on an outreach basis.
- Staff can access from home.
